Recommendations: Use of Mifepristone (RU486) n the treatment of medical

conditions, such as cancer, for which RU486 may provide effective therapy, the drug should be used in keeping with relevant laws and established medical science.

- 2. RU486 is also used for contraception. When the effect of the drug is to prevent fertilization, its use is ethically permissi- ble. Like other oral contraceptives, however, RU486 may some- times prevent implantation of a fertilized ovum. This is ethically problematic to those who consider this effect to be abortion.
- 3. When RU486 is used in legally permissible and medical- ly appropriate ways for the purpose of causing abortion, the previously adopted Seventh-day Adventist Guidelines on Abortion should guide the practice.
